<i>June 20 Thursday</i>	<i>Depart USA.</i> Departure from Los Angeles Airport on a flight to Prague, Czech Republic. Meals served on board.
<i>June 21 Friday</i>	<i>Prague.</i> Arrive in Prague and after late afternoon hotel check-in, free time to relax followed by 7:00pm Welcome Dinner.
<i>June 22 Saturday</i>	<i>Prague.</i> Morning Rehearsal, followed by free time for lunch on your own. Next is a walking tour of Prague Castle - one of the largest and most magnificent castles in Europe. The seat of the Czech Government, Prague Castle houses the office of the President and is the site of parliamentary meetings of importance. As you walk among 1000 years of history and architecture, you will see the Gallery, the Gardens, Spanish Hall, and the majestic St. Vitus Cathedral, one of the oldest and most remarkable churches in Prague, whose spires grace the horizon at the highest location in the city. You will visit St. George's Basilica, and the Golden Lane, where medieval alchemists tried to turn lead into gold. 
<i>June 23 Sunday</i>	<i>Prague.</i> Your sightseeing today will start at Wenceslas Square, the heart of the capital, founded in 1348 as an important link between the Old Town and the New Town fortifications. A short walk away, situated on Old Town Square, you will discover the most popular tourist attraction in Prague, the Astronomical Clock with its intricate representations of the zodiac and the rural heritage of the people. Across the Square, you will visit the Tyn Church, dating back to the 14th

century. 2-3pm individual rehearsal & 3-4pm rehearse with all choirs. 4:30pm return to the hotel to relax, dress and get ready for 6:00pm transfer to concert for a short Rehearsal and 8:00pm FESTIVAL CONCERT.



**June 24
Monday**

Prague. All day free for own leisure. Optional Evening Boat Cruise on the Vltava River, at extra cost, for those wishing this wonderful experience.

**June 25
Tuesday**

Kraków. Morning hotel check-out and flight to Kraków, Poland. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel for check-in. 3:00pm Rehearsal, followed by dinner and free evening.

**June 26
Wednesday**


Kraków. All day sightseeing starting with a visit to Wawel Castle, an immense complex housing a diverse collection of paintings and furniture that outline the first several centuries of Polish history. You will also see the Old Market Square with the Cloth Hall and Mariacki Church, Jagiellonian University, one of the oldest in Europe, and Jewish Kazimierz, a center of Jewish traditions and culture. 5:00pm Rehearsal.



**June 27
Thursday**

Kraków. Morning tour of Wieliczka, the world famous salt mines, located just outside of Kraków. The mines contain magnificent natural and man-made features in the hundreds of miles of underground tunnels and caverns. Underground carvings in rock salt include a great hall and an inspiring Chapel of the Blessed Kinga. 4:00pm return to the hotel to relax and get ready for 6:00pm Rehearsal and 8:00pm FESTIVAL CONCERT, followed by a Festive Dinner.



<p>June 28 Friday</p>	<p>Auschwitz/Pieskowa Skala Castle/Kraków. Morning tour of Auschwitz (Oświęcim) - the former largest Nazi concentration camp, now the state museum displaying shocking evidence of the massive murders that took place here between 1940 and 1945. Afternoon visit to Pieskowa Skala Castle, one of the best-known examples of a defensive Polish Renaissance architecture erected in the first half of the 14th century as part of the chain of fortified castles called Orle Gniazda (Eagles Nests).</p> 
<p>June 29 Saturday</p>	<p>Kraków. Free day for own leisure. <i>EVENING INDIVIDUAL CONCERT.</i></p>
<p>June 30 Sunday</p>	<p>Return USA. Early morning transfer to the airport for a flight back to Los Angeles arriving the same afternoon/evening.</p>
