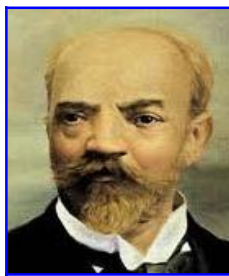

1. Volkmar Leisring: **Let All the Nations Praise the Lord* – SSAATTBB with organ, English 1'38"
2. Antonin Dvořák: **Gloria from Mass in D* – SATB & piano – sung in Latin 2'23"
3. Antonin Dvořák: **Sanctus from Mass in D* – SATB & piano – sung in Latin 2'31"
4. Giovanni Gabrielli: **Hodie Christus Natus Est*, Chorale – SATB *a cappella*, sung in Latin 3'00"
5. Vladimír Godár: **Regina Coeli* – SATB & organ (or piano) – sung in Latin 5'54"
6. Randall Thompson: **Alleluia* – SATB *a cappella*, single word “Alleluia” only, Latin 4'51"
7. Henryk Mikołaj Górecki: **Totus Tuus* – SATB *a cappella*, sung in Latin 7'10"
8. Henryk Mikołaj Górecki: **Szeroka Woda*, op 39, 1979, SATB *a cappella*, sung in Polish 2'21"
9. Paweł Łukaszewski: **Nunc dimittis* – SATB & orchestra (piano arr. ?), sung in Latin 4'00"

INTERMISSION

2ND HALF OF PROGRAM – INDIVIDUAL CHOIR SELECTIONS

Each Choir will perform 2 selections from their own repertoire to perform alone. Each selection should not exceed 4 minutes. The selections may be *a cappella* or accompanied with piano.

The Concert will conclude with all choirs joining together, stationed in antiphonal-style setting, facing the audience, singing perhaps one of the most famous choral Canons, *Donna Nobis Pacem*.
